- Contract is extendable upto total number of 10 terms for doctors from the open market and upto total number of 05 terms for Retired Railway Doctors and Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors on year to year basis or till they attain 65 years of age, whichever is earliest.

Medical examination of candidates will be held after the Walk-in-interview, on a date to be intimated on day of interview.

Note:

- Candidates should submit their application in duplicate on the prescribed Proforma enclosed herewith latest by 10:30 AM at the above mentioned venue on the date of walk-in-interview.
- In case it is not possible to interview/medically examine all the candidates on the nominated day, they will be interviewed/medically examined on the next working day/days. Thus, the candidates should make their own arrangement for stay for a period of two days and come prepared accordingly.

Remuneration:- Consolidated remuneration at the rate of Rs. 55000/- for General Duty Doctor per month will be admissible, if Govt. accommodation is not provided. If Govt. accommodation is provided an amount equivalent to House Rent Allowance payable to a fresh entrant to Group 'A' Jr. Scale and License fee of Railway accommodation so provided shall be deducted from the monthly remuneration payable to the CMP.

Remuneration for retired Railway Doctors & Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors: Consolidated remuneration at the rate of Rs. 48000/- per month will be admissible (subject to the condition that remuneration + pension drawn should not exceed the last pay drawn), if Govt. accommodation is not provided. If Govt. accommodation is provided an amount equivalent to House Rent allowance payable to a fresh entrant to Group 'A' Jr. Scale and License fee of Railway accommodation so provided shall be deducted from the monthly remuneration payable to the CMP.

Age Limits:-

Candidates should not have competed more than 60 years of age as on 01.01.2017.

Age for Retired Railway Doctors and Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors:- Candidates should not have completed more than 63 years & 06 months of age as on 01.01.2017.

Terms & Conditions:- Engagement of doctors would be on contract basis initially for a period of one year on annual basis up to a maximum of 10 terms as per administrative requirement on the basis of assessment of performance of CMPs. However, services of these doctors can be terminated even before the expiry of one year after giving 15 days notice on either side. Railway administration reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time during the contract by giving 15 days notice or payment of 15 days remuneration without assigning any reason whatsoever. The services rendered as contract doctor is a stop gap arrangement and will not be taken into consideration in case of their selection through UPSC. It will also not confer upon them any right for regularization or permanent absorption in the Railways. The engagement shall purely be on contract basis for a period of one year or till the regular incumbent joins or on Retired Railway Doctors & Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors attaining the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier. Contract is liable to be terminated, if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated.

Terms & Conditions for Retired Railway Doctors and Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors:- Engagement of Retired Railway Doctors & Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors as CMPs shall be for a maximum of 05 (five) years. The contract shall be entered into for a period of one year or less from the date of entering into the contract subject to completion of 65 years of age. The engagement shall purely be on contract basis for a period of one year or till a regular incumbent joins or on the Retired Railway Doctors & Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors attaining the age of 65 years, whichever is earliest. The Retired Railway Doctors & Central/State Govt. Retired Doctors engaged as CMP shall not have any claim or right for his/her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract. During the validity of the contract, the CMP shall be at liberty to terminate on any ground by giving 15 days notice to the Railways. Railway Administration reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time during the contract by giving 15 days notice or payment of 15 days remuneration without assigning any reason whatsoever. Contract is liable to be terminated, if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated.

Essential Educational Qualifications:-

For General Duty Doctors: MBBS degree (with completion of internship) by any University/Institution recognized by Indian Medical Council.

Experience

For General Duty Doctors, candidates with experience will be given preference.

Note:-

- The doctors so engaged on contract basis will not be allowed private practice.
- The contract doctors shall not be entitled for Railway Quarter as a matter of right.
- Candidates should bring their application form alongwith original and attested copies of all certificates and mark-sheets. No TADA is admissible.

(iv) The offer of engagement to the selected candidates shall be issued subject to the availability of vacancy as per requirement in MCF/RBL Hospital. Administration reserves the right to change the number of posts/vacancies as per administrative needs.

(vi) After approval of the panel by competent authority, the panel will be uploaded at MCF/RBL's website www.mcf.Indianrailways.gov.in. The candidates who do not report at the assigned date and time will forfeit their chance of contract engagement and such engagement will be offered to the next empanelled candidate.
